Houston talks on Poland-US energy cooperation

"Access to American gas is an important factor in ensuring Poland's energy security," underscored Minister Witold Waszczykowski speaking with Cheniere Energy Board of Directors. During his Houston visit, the Polish foreign policy chief discussed the prospects for further cooperation in supplying American Liquified Natural Gas (LNG) to the Swinoujscie LNG terminal. "US LNG supplies enhance energy security of our region, make us less dependent on the dominant supplier and bring benefits to Polish and American economies," said Minister Waszczykowski.

The first LNG shipment to Poland took place last June, originating from Cheniere's Sabine Pass terminal in Louisiana. This was the first LNG shipment to Central and Eastern Europe. Minister Waszczykowski talked about the development of economic cooperation between Poland and Texas with Texan business leaders who belong to the Greater Houston Partnership.

Minister Witold Waszczykowski also met with the management board of ExxonMobil. He stated, "We would like to expand our economic cooperation, go[ing] far beyond the security area which has so far dominated Poland-US relations." Among all the states, Texas is Poland's main commercial partner with a trade volume of USD 857 million. Recent years have seen the value of Polish exports to Texas more than double. The key Polish export is electronic devices.

Special guests to this year's celebration included Minister Anna Maria Anders, the Prime Minister's Plenipotentiary for International Dialogue, as well as World War II veterans and Polish veterans of deployments to Iraq and Afghanistan.

Polish Olympic Squad Named

Fifty-eight athletes will represent Poland at the 2018 Olympic Games in PyeongChang, Korea. Two-time Olympic medalist Zbigniew Bródka will carry the Polish national flag during the Games' opening ceremonies.



Team Poland will field competitors in the following disciplines: Alpine skiing, biathlon, bobsleigh, cross-country skiing, figure skating, freestyle skiing, luge, Nordic combined, short track speed skating, ski jumping, snowboarding and speed skating.

Poland won six medals: four gold, one silver and one bronze, during the previous winter Olympics in Sochi, Russia, in 2014, the best ever Olympic Winter Games tally for Poland.

Polish co-production Loving Vincent nominated for an Oscar



Polish-British animation and the world's first fully painted film *Loving Vincent* has been nominated for Best Animated Feature Film at the 2018 Academy Awards!

Loving Vincent, the world's first fully-painted animated feature film, brings the paintings of Vincent van Gogh to life to tell his remarkable story. Every one of the 65,000 frames of the film is an oil-painting hand-painted by 125 professional oil-painters. The film was directed by Poland's Dorota Kobiela and Britain's Hugh Welchman.
